



Career-wise Researcher

The Career-wise Researcher is a one-day training course for doctoral and early career researchers. This career development programme enables participants to gain a clearer self-orientation of where they are within their career, their competencies and interests, and to consider what their next steps may be, whether their aspirations are to remain in research and/or academia or to move into other areas, and how best to present themselves to employers. The Vitae RDF employability lens is used to help researchers focus on relevant competencies.

During the workshop, participants will:

- Broaden their horizons to career possibilities within academia and beyond
- Widen their understanding of what makes for a successful career
- Consider where they would like to be in the future and make plans to get there
- Explore their strengths, motivations, values and talents
- Identify potential jobs they might like to explore further
- Commit to a personal action plan

By the end of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- distinguish a wide range of potential career possibilities
- recognise their own competences
- match potential career possibilities to their own competences, values and drivers
- present themselves effectively to employers
- create a realistic and achievable plan of action to seek out employment opportunities

This is a full day career management workshop for doctoral and early career researchers.
