



Researcher Futures: Making your mark

This course aims to help researchers make their mark. The course will draw on the current agendas of research impact demonstrated by the funding bodies and grant holders, but with specific focus on the individual and how they work. Specifically the course will:

 - how they communicate their research
 - how they engage with those connected to their research
- Explore the impact of their research by:
 - understanding the context of their research
 - considering the beneficiaries of their research
 - managing the implications of their research
